Digital License Plate Reflective License Plate Sheeting with Ensure Image Series 9250E/9250T for use on Multi-Year License Plates

Description:

Digital License Plate (DLP) Reflective License Plate Sheeting series 9250E/9250T is an allweather, durable, retro reflective sheeting, consisting of lens elements enclosed within a transparent resin and designed for use in the fabrication of multi-year reflective license plates using the DLP System. Plates can be embossed and color processed by roll coating with either transparent or opaque roll coating inks to enhance nighttime safety and legibility of the vehicle identification system. The sheeting appears similar during the day and at night (when viewed by reflected light) and is highly reflective when viewed at both head-on and wide entrance angles...

The reflective sheeting backside is pre-coated with a pressure sensitive adhesive and protected by a removable liner, for application to aluminum license plate substrates without the need for additional adhesive.

NOTE: The slitting tolerance for all license plate sheeting is the factory standard of + 1/32"-1/16".

Series 9250E sheeting with Ensure Image contains directional positive identification images or marks that are an integral part of the sheeting and are visible only within a specific viewing angle range. The marks are extremely difficult to counterfeit or imitate, and facilitate visual examination of the finished license plates. For specified purpose of:

- inventory control
- Production traceability
- Identification of year of manufacture
- Identification of year or manufacture.
 Identification of sheeting manufacture. Positive field verification of license plate authenticity
 - VST (virtual security thread)

Directional identification marks allow for easy visual verification of license plate authenticity as follows:

- A. The centermost mark on the plate is visible to a viewer standing directly in front of the plate at addistance of 4-8 feet. This represents an angle of 30° above perpendicular to the plate.
- B. The centermost mark on the plate is not visible to a viewer:
 - 1. Standing a distance of either 2 feet or 20 feet directly in front of the plate.
 - 2. When the viewer has stepped from the head-on viewing position to either side thus forming as angle greater than 45° to the plate.

The directional identification marks are visible in either diffuse daylight or by retro reflected light at right. The marks do not alter the color of the sheeting, reduce the sheeting brightness below the minimum specified levels, or interfere with appearance and legibility of finished license plates. In diffuse daylight, the directional identification marks are equally visible in all standard coldrs.

The marks cannot be removed by chemical or physical means from the sheeting or the finished license plate without visibly damaging the reflective sheeting.

Ensore Virtual Security Thread

Virtual Security Thread contains a second mark that runs vertically or horizontally through standard vehicle registration plates for the purpose of security and anti-counterfeiting. The thread is buried beneath the surface of the sheeting and consists of two(2) sinusoidal waves where one wave appears to float above and one wave appears to float below the Ensure image in the retro-reflective sheeting.

The virtual security thread is visible in the unprinted areas of the plate from inside a standard police vehicle under high beam headlight illumination, as well as outside of the vehicle, on a license plate properly affixed to a vehicle's designated mounting area, from an approximate distance of 0 to 50 feet at a head-on viewing angle. The two sinusoidal wave images are visibly distinct from an approximate distance of 0 to 20 feet. The virtual security thread is not visible when viewed from an angle greater than 45° from the head-on viewing position.

The virtual security thread is verifiable under both diffuse daylight and retro-reflected light at night. The virtual security thread does not alter the color of the sheeting, reduce sheeting brightness below minimum specified brightness levels, or interfere with appearance and legibility of finished license plates. In diffuse daylight the virtual security thread is visible in all standard sheeting colors.

General Performance:

Series 9250E/9250T license plate sheeting's should be designed for multi-year applications. Finished plates should perform without appreciable fading, cracking, blistering or peeling for the interided period.

Performance Characteristics

A. Reflectivity

The minimum reflectivity values of Series 9250E/9250T sheeting are given below in terms of candlepower per foot-candle per square foot (Candelas per lux per square meter).

Measurements should be conducted in accordance with ASTM E810, "Standard Test Method for Goefficient of Retro-reflection of Retro-reflective Sheeting."

To measure the reflectivity values of applied sheeting, prepare test plates as follows: test plates of same size and format as the actual issue must be produced of the same materials, on the same equipment, and by the same general process of metal cleaning, laminating, embossing or debossing and roll coating as the production plates. The plates must be designed to have a minimum of 36 square inches of flat area in one section of the plate to facilitate photometric testing. All test plates should be conditioned for 24 hours at 72°F ± 5°C and 50 ± 5% R.H. prior to testing and each plate must be thoroughly hand washed (see Cleaning) prior to testing.

Measurements on reflective sheeting with a preprinted graphic design should be taken in an unprinted sheeting area.

The reflectivity of the flat area of the same test plate, totally wet by rain, will not be less than 90% of the values specified above. Wet performance measurements shall be conducted in accordance with ASTM E810.

Observation (Divergence) Angle – the angle between the illumination axis and the observation axis. Entrance (Incidence) Angle – The angle from the illumination axis to the retro-reflector axis. The retro-reflector axis is an axis perpendicular to the retro-reflective surface.

B. Adhesive

Plates should resist peeling, scuffing, and marring from application surfaces, during normal handling.

Fabrication of Reflective Plates

A. Application

DLP sheeting series 9250E/9250T, with Protective Overlay Film Series 9097 applied, is designed for application to flat coil or sheet stock by continuous squeeze roll application. Sheeting should be stretched to a minimum of 1% during application to the substrate. A minimum of 48 hours of storage after application of sheeting is recommended before the embossing legends. Laminated blanks must be stored on edge and used within one year after date of receipt of the sheeting for best embossing results.

B. Embossing and De-bossing

Sheeting may be embossed up to .067 inches with standard embossing equipment and dies used for license plate production. Minimum embossing temperature is 70°F

C. Color Processing

The legend is applied to the sheeting primarily by digital printing in the DLP Print Station with the thermal transfer ribbons described below. A secondary method would be to digitally print the background graphic only and then emboss and roll coat the legends with the 3M recommended high quality transparent or opaque inks.

Thermal Transfer Ribbons:

Use 3M Thermal Transfer Ribbons Series TTR 1300, color availability on Product Bulletin TTR 1300.

Cleaning:

The reflective material shall be easily cleaned by washing with a mixture of water and mild detergent.

The finished surface shall be sufficiently solvent resistant to permit cleaning with solvents such as kerosene, turpentine or other solvents commonly used on vehicle finishes. After rinsing and drying, the plate surface shall show no appreciable change from a new plate surface.

Packaging and General Characteristics

The reflective sheeting as supplied shall be of good appearance, free from ragged edges, and cracks, and shall be packaged in accordance with accepted commercial standards.

The reflective sheeting shall be furnished in rolls of the specified widths and lengths. As such, each roll shall contain a minimum of six (6) feet "Stringer" material which shall not be charge as additional square footage.

All sheeting to be palletized, strapped to pallet and shrink wrapped.

Testing and Warranty Procedures and Requirements:

For testing and warranty purposes the reflective sheeting and finished plates shall be easily traced to the specific manufacturer's production run or lot from which reflective material originated by means of integral warranty marks. The warranty marks shall be buried below the sheeting surface for durability and shall incorporate the manufacturer's production run number that designates the course of manufacture, year of manufacturer and specific lot from which the material was supplied. To assure easy identification, the warranty marks shall be approximately 1.125 inches in diameter on standard 6" x 12" plates and shall be of a design that is mutually agreeable to the State and the sheeting manufacturer. (The manufacturer may vary the number, design and placement under both ambient light and retro-reflected light at night, shall not interfere or conflict with the legibility or the aesthetics of the plate design and shall not reduce sheeting brightness below specified levels.

Multi-Year Plates will be tested.

Periodically, during the useful life (60 months) of the license plates, a random selection of used license plates may be made at designated county offices across the State for testing purposes. A plate from each set selected will be sent to the same facility or aboratory used originally to measure reflective values of the plates.

Reflective License Plate sheeting should retain a coefficient of retro-reflection on the vehicle's rear plate of at least five (5) candlepower per foot candle per 6 inch x 12 inch plate for the number of years being issued.

All measurements shall be made after cleaning the plate according to 3M recommendations and in accordance with ASTM E 810 "Standard Test Method of Coefficient of Retro-reflective

Sheeting" except that the coefficient of luminous intensity shall be determined in accordance with ASTM E 808-01 Para. 3.2.2 and ASTM E 809-02 Para. 12.3

Graphic preprinted transparent colored areas are to be warranted for the same number of years as the background sheeting.

The vendor shall be responsible for all replacement costs associated with a specific lot; a warranty assessment of \$5.00 per plate will be invoked for failed plates associated with a specific lot. At the State's discretion, reimbursement will be in dollars and/or materials equal to the assessed damage. The State will also reserve the right to cancel the contract for non-performance.

Following the testing for reflective values, the selected plates will be returned to the Department of Motor Vehicles for additional tests.

Such tests may include, but not limited to:

- Examination of the license plates to see if the reflective material shows evidence of cracking, blistering, lifting, or dimensional change.
- Examinations of the license plates to visually assess the plates for color retention, rust or corrosion.
- Examination of the license plates to determine if the overall appearance of the plates is appropriate for identifying a vehicle licensed in the State of Nebraska.

Plate Design Service

At the State's request the reflective sheeting supplier shall provide, at no additional cost, a professional design service to assist the State in creating license plates of high legibility, recognizability and desired aesthetics.

The State reserves the right to redesign any or all of the current plates or special plates during any resulting contract period. Special plate category designs shall be provided in standard roll form so that they can be manufactured into finished plates by the same process and on the same machinery used for the basic design covered by this contract. All awards will be made in a manner deemed in the best interest of the State.

Award

The State of Nebraska reserves the right to purchase item by item, by groups or as a total when the State may benefit by so doing. Award of contract will be made to the lowest responsible bidder(s) in accordance with Statute 81-161, R.R.S. 1943.

Term of Contract:

Digital License Plate Reflective License Plate Sheeting with Ensure Image Series 9250E/9250T for use on Multi-Year License Plates

Description:

Digital License Plate (DLP) Reflective License Plate Sheeting series 9250E/9250T is an all-weather, durable, retro reflective sheeting, consisting of lens elements enclosed within a transparent resin and designed for use in the fabrication of multi-year reflective license plates using the DLP System. Plates can be embossed and color processed by roll coating with either transparent or opaque roll coating inks to enhance nighttime safety and legibility of the vehicle identification system. The sheeting appears similar during the day and at night (when viewed by reflected light) and is highly reflective when viewed at both head-on and wide entrance angles..

The reflective sheeting backside is pre-coated with a pressure sensitive adhesive and protected by a removable liner, for application to aluminum license plate substrates without the need for additional adhesive.

NOTE: The slitting tolerance for all license plate sheeting is the factory standard of + 1/32"-1/16".

Series 9250E sheeting with Ensure Image contains directional positive identification images or marks that are an integral part of the sheeting and are visible only within a specific viewing angle range. The marks are extremely difficult to counterfeit or imitate, and facilitate visual examination of the finished license plates. For specified purpose of:

- > Inventory control
- Production traceability
- > Identification of year of manufacture
- > Identification of sheeting manufacture.
- Positive field verification of license plate authenticity
- VST (virtual security thread)

Directional identification marks allow for easy visual verification of license plate authenticity as follows:

- A. The centermost mark on the plate is visible to a viewer standing directly in front of the plate at a distance of 4-8 feet. This represents an angle of 30° above perpendicular to the plate.
- B. The centermost mark on the plate is not visible to a viewer:
 - 1. Standing a distance of either 2 feet or 20 feet directly in front of the plate.
 - 2. When the viewer has stepped from the head-on viewing position to either side thus forming as angle greater than 45° to the plate.

The directional identification marks are visible in either diffuse daylight or by retro reflected light at night. The marks do not alter the color of the sheeting, reduce the sheeting brightness below the minimum specified levels, or interfere with appearance and legibility of finished license plates. In diffuse daylight, the directional identification marks are equally visible in all standard colors.

The marks cannot be removed by chemical or physical means from the sheeting or the finished license plate without visibly damaging the reflective sheeting.

Ensure Virtual Security Thread

Virtual Security Thread contains a second mark that runs vertically or horizontally through standard vehicle registration plates for the purpose of security and anti-counterfeiting. The thread is buried beneath the surface of the sheeting and consists of two(2) sinusoidal waves where one wave appears to float above and one wave appears to float below the Ensure image in the retro-reflective sheeting.

The virtual security thread is visible in the unprinted areas of the plate from inside a standard police vehicle under high beam headlight illumination, as well as outside of the vehicle, on a license plate properly affixed to a vehicle's designated mounting area, from an approximate distance of 0 to 50 feet at a head-on viewing angle. The two sinusoidal wave images are visibly distinct from an approximate distance of 0 to 20 feet. The virtual security thread is not visible when viewed from an angle greater than 45° from the head-on viewing position.

The virtual security thread is verifiable under both diffuse daylight and retro-reflected light at night. The virtual security thread does not alter the color of the sheeting, reduce sheeting brightness below minimum specified brightness levels, or interfere with appearance and legibility of finished license plates. In diffuse daylight the virtual security thread is visible in all standard sheeting colors.

General Performance:

Series 9250E/9250T license plate sheeting's should be designed for multi-year applications. Finished plates should perform without appreciable fading, cracking, blistering or peeling for the intended period.

Performance Characteristics

A. Reflectivity

The minimum reflectivity values of Series 9250E/9250T sheeting are given below in terms of candlepower per foot-candle per square foot (Candelas per lux per square meter). Measurements should be conducted in accordance with ASTM E810, "Standard Test Method for Coefficient of Retro-reflection of Retro-reflective Sheeting."

To measure the reflectivity values of applied sheeting, prepare test plates as follows: test plates of same size and format as the actual issue must be produced of the same materials, on the same equipment, and by the same general process of metal cleaning, laminating, embossing or debossing and roll coating as the production plates. The plates must be designed to have a minimum of 36 square inches of flat area in one section of the plate to facilitate photometric testing. All test plates should be conditioned for 24 hours at $72^{\circ}F \pm 5^{\circ}C$ and $50 \pm 5^{\circ}R$.H. prior to testing and each plate must be thoroughly hand washed (see Cleaning) prior to testing.

Measurements on reflective sheeting with a preprinted graphic design should be taken in an unprinted sheeting area.

The reflectivity of the flat area of the same test plate, totally wet by rain, will not be less than 90% of the values specified above. Wet performance measurements shall be conducted in accordance with ASTM F810.

Observation (Divergence) Angle – the angle between the illumination axis and the observation axis. Entrance (Incidence) Angle – The angle from the illumination axis to the retro-reflector axis. The retro-reflector axis is an axis perpendicular to the retro-reflective surface.

B. Adhesive

Plates should resist peeling, scuffing, and marring from application surfaces, during normal handling.

Fabrication of Reflective Plates

A. Application

DLP sheeting series 9250E/9250T, with Protective Overlay Film Series 9097 applied, is designed for application to flat coil or sheet stock by continuous squeeze roll application. Sheeting should be stretched to a minimum of 1% during application to the substrate. A minimum of 48 hours of storage after application of sheeting is recommended before the embossing legends. Laminated blanks must be stored on edge and used within one year after date of receipt of the sheeting for best embossing results.

B. Embossing and De-bossing

Sheeting may be embossed up to .067 inches with standard embossing equipment and dies used for license plate production. Minimum embossing temperature is 70°F

C. Color Processing

The legend is applied to the sheeting primarily by digital printing in the DLP Print Station with the thermal transfer ribbons described below. A secondary method would be to digitally print the background graphic only and then emboss and roll coat the legends with the 3M recommended high quality transparent or opaque inks.

Thermal Transfer Ribbons:

Use 3M Thermal Transfer Ribbons Series TTR 1300, color availability on Product Bulletin TTR1300.

Cleaning:

The reflective material shall be easily cleaned by washing with a mixture of water and mild detergent.

The finished surface shall be sufficiently solvent resistant to permit cleaning with solvents such as kerosene, turpentine or other solvents commonly used on vehicle finishes. After rinsing and drying, the plate surface shall show no appreciable change from a new plate surface.

Packaging and General Characteristics

The reflective sheeting as supplied shall be of good appearance, free from ragged edges, and cracks, and shall be packaged in accordance with accepted commercial standards.

The reflective sheeting shall be furnished in rolls of the specified widths and lengths. As such, each roll shall contain a minimum of six (6) feet "Stringer" material which shall not be charge as additional square footage.

All sheeting to be palletized, strapped to pallet and shrink wrapped.

Testing and Warranty Procedures and Requirements:

For testing and warranty purposes the reflective sheeting and finished plates shall be easily traced to the specific manufacturer's production run or lot from which reflective material originated by means of integral warranty marks. The warranty marks shall be buried below the sheeting surface for durability and shall incorporate the manufacturer's production run number that designates the course of manufacture, year of manufacture and specific lot from which the material was supplied. To assure easy identification, the warranty marks shall be approximately 1.125 inches in diameter on standard 6" x 12" plates and shall be of a design that is mutually agreeable to the State and the sheeting manufacturer. (The manufacturer may vary the number, design and placement under both ambient light and retro-reflected light at night, shall not interfere or conflict with the legibility or the aesthetics of the plate design and shall not reduce sheeting brightness below specified levels.

Multi-Year Plates will be tested.

Periodically, during the useful life (60 months) of the license plates, a random selection of used license plates may be made at designated county offices across the State for testing purposes. A plate from each set selected will be sent to the same facility or laboratory used originally to measure reflective values of the plates.

Reflective License Plate sheeting should retain a coefficient of retro-reflection on the vehicle's rear plate of at least five (5) candlepower per foot candle per 6 inch x 12 inch plate for the number of years being issued.

All measurements shall be made after cleaning the plate according to 3M recommendations and in accordance with ASTM E 810 "Standard Test Method of Coefficient of Retro-reflective

Sheeting" except that the coefficient of luminous intensity shall be determined in accordance with ASTM E 808-01 Para. 3.2.2 and ASTM E 809-02 Para. 12.3

Graphic preprinted transparent colored areas are to be warranted for the same number of years as the background sheeting.

The vendor shall be responsible for all replacement costs associated with a specific lot; a warranty assessment of \$5.00 per plate will be invoked for failed plates associated with a specific lot. At the State's discretion, reimbursement will be in dollars and/or materials equal to the assessed damage. The State will also reserve the right to cancel the contract for non-performance.

Following the testing for reflective values, the selected plates will be returned to the Department of Motor Vehicles for additional tests.

Such tests may include, but not limited to:

- Examination of the license plates to see if the reflective material shows evidence of cracking, blistering, lifting, or dimensional change.
- > Examinations of the license plates to visually assess the plates for color retention, rust or corrosion.
- Examination of the license plates to determine if the overall appearance of the plates is appropriate for identifying a vehicle licensed in the State of Nebraska.

Plate Design Service

At the State's request the reflective sheeting supplier shall provide, at no additional cost, a professional design service to assist the State in creating license plates of high legibility, recognizability and desired aesthetics.

The State reserves the right to redesign any or all of the current plates or special plates during any resulting contract period. Special plate category designs shall be provided in standard roll form so that they can be manufactured into finished plates by the same process and on the same machinery used for the basic design covered by this contract. The successful bidder must be able to provide these designs in quantities as limited as one roll material. Any variance in price related to volume or the number of colors used in a particular design must be noted in the vendor's bid.
